MINISTER BEGINS NEW SERIES OF SERMONS

Reading parts of the fourteenth, fifteenth and sixteenth chapters of John's Gospel as a basis for his remarks concerning the Holy Spirit of God, J. Scott Greer brought his first message, in a series, pertaining to the work of the Holy Spirit at the West Point Church of Christ, Sunday morning, April 7th.

As an introduction to these messages the pastor pointed out, from his observation, that most Christians had lost sight of the Bible's doctrine concerning the person, work and comfort of the Holy Spirit. Strong emphasis was also placed upon the Holy Spirit's being One in the Holy Trinity—a real person and not a mere thing. Said he, "The Holy Spirit is referred to no less than twenty-two times in the Gospel of John by the Pronouns, the him, whom and himself, thus declaring the Holy Spirit to be a person. This being true does not behoove Christians to be guided by the third person of the Godhead? Even though many may be deluded as to the operation of the Spirit and have become fanatical about these things, this by no means gives Christians excuse to disregard the subject altogether."

The discourse was given over largely to the discussion of how the Holy Spirit convicts of sin, guides into all truth and seals unto the day of redemption. Also attention was called to the fact of His being grieved and sometimes blasphemed.

4-H Clubs Start Bird-Study Groups
Michigan 4-H Club enrollees in bird study groups hailed the official return of spring as the season to start observation of migratory bird nesting.

A. O. Hansen, of the Michigan Department of Conservation and extension service of Michigan State College, informs bird study groups that in many species the males are the first to return north. In the redwinged blackbird, the males arrive early, "stake claims" on prospective nesting sites, and defend such territories against intruder males of their own kind. The females arrive later and pick a male and territory to suit their fancy, Hansen reveals.
