

Covenant Plans Easter Week Series Of Films



"THE RESTLESS ONES," opening the Covenant Community Church film series Saturday, April 1, has many dramatic moments.

A five - night series of dramatic and documentary films will open Saturday, April 1, in Covenant Community Church, 2800 Student, Redford Township, with the showing of the full - length action feature, "The Restless Ones."

The film, to be screened at 7 p.m., stars Johnny Crawford, Kim Darby, Robert Sampson and Georgia Lee.

Other films in the series, to be sponsored by the church, include "The Heart Is a Rebel," scheduled at 7 p.m. Easter Sunday, April 2, "Lucia," at 7:15 p.m. Monday, April 3 and "Shadow of the Boomerang," at 7:15 p.m. Tuesday, April 4.

ALL THE PICTURES are full - length color features produced by World Wide Pictures, the film division of the Billy Graham organization.

The Rev. John Drummond, pastor of Covenant, said all films would be open to the public and free of charge.

All five films, he noted, represent high achievement in movie making because they are high - caliber entertainment as well as carrying a Christian message. He called opening show "an explosive action film that has been shown in hundreds of theaters across the nation and

has had significant impact upon thousands of young lives."

Strengthening the spiritual life of the community" was cited by the pastor as the main reason for the church's sponsorship of the film series.

"THE RESTLESS ONES" is a story of teen - age crisis, with a background setting provided by the 1963 Billy Graham Los Angeles Crusade. The Christian message is set in a realist teen situation.

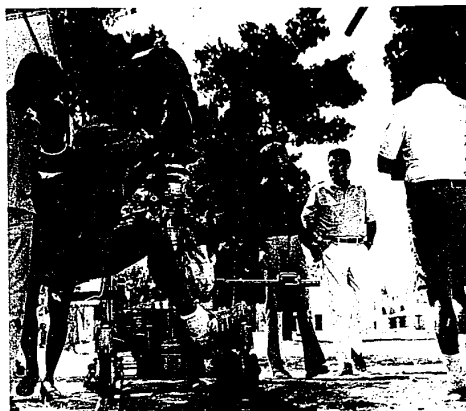
"The Heart Is a Rebel," starring Ethel Waters, Georgia Lee and John Milford, is based on a conflict in the life of a modern young couple when the husband, an advertising executive, finds it hard to understand his wife's sudden acceptance of the Christian faith. A Graham crusade in Madison Square Gardens in New York provides the background, and there is music by the 1,500 - voice Crusade Choir under the direction of Cliff Barrows.

Buenos Aires is the setting for "Lucia," an all production work was done in the South American city. Featuring gaucha music and scenic grandeur of Argentina, its story enters the area of domestic discord and romantic triangle and what the Bible has to say in

resolving emotional problems. "Shadow of the Boomerang," was filmed in the outback interior region of Australia and records the story of an American brother and sister who arrive in the land - down - under to manage

newly - acquired family holdings. It attempts to underline the Christian's reaction to crises and conflict.

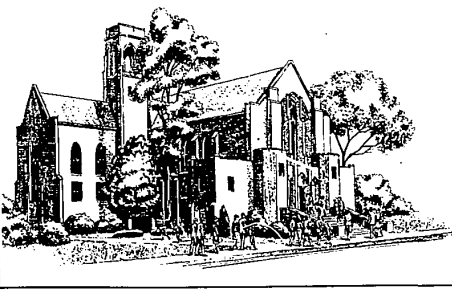
