

NEW SUBDIVISION IS OPENED ON EIGHT MILE ROAD

Residents of nearby villages were evacuated in a precautionary measure. No lives have been lost, but a lot of damage is inflicted upon grazing lands, which are rapidly being covered with ashes.

Jane Putman who was operated on for appendicitis was progressing rapidly.



OAKLAND COUNTY PLANS MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM

A long felt need for the general public to have an opportunity to become informed regarding problems of mental health is now being met in Oakland County. An Oakland County Branch of the Michigan Society for Mental Hygiene has recently been formed. It is a purpose of this organization to conduct instructional programs on various phases of mental health on a level that can be understood by the layman. It is hoped that this group may be able to bring about a better working relationship between various existing agencies in the field of mental health and encourage the establishment of other needed resources.

This organization was formed to meet the need brought about by the realization of the importance of an understanding of mental health problems by every person.

The old community mental health center, which was established to help the totally mentally ill has fallen

on scientific findings of recent years. With the understanding that every person has problems of mental health confronting them through their lifetime, the need for an opportunity to become acquainted with the scientific aspect is apparent.
