A BLUEBIRD HOUSE should have a five



A WREN HOUSE floor should be four-byfour inches, with a depth of six to eight inches and an entrance diameter of one inch. This makes a house large enough for a wren but too small for a sparrow. A perch may be used if the builder wishes, but if it is usurped by sparrows who keep the wrens away it is better to remove ti. The house may be hung in a tree or placed six to 10 feet above the ground on trellises or shrub borders. Make certain the entrance is well above floor level so baby birds will not fall out.
