## Judge Gilbert Wants Court Seat

Judge Alice L. Gilbert, district judge for the 48th Judicial District, Oakland County, is seeking election to Circuit Court in Oakland County.

Two new Circuit Court judgeships were created in 1970, increasing the number of judges on the bench from nine to 11 by next January.

In her 11th year on the bench, Judge Gilbert, 39, currently serves as district judge in the 48th district. She was previously elected twice as a justice of the peace in Bloomfield Township, and served as judge for Bloomfield Hills for two years.

GILBERT said she was responsible for the formation of the Michigan District Judges' Association and

served as its president in 1969 and 1970.

She also served as chairman of the Oakland County District Judges' Association in 1970, and holds memberships in several local and national bar associations.

She was admitted to practice law in the U.S. Supreme Court in 1964, and participated in the National Conference of Special Court Judges in 1970.

Her community activities include service on the Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Planning Council and on the Northern Oakland County Girl Scout Council.

A lecturer for the Institute of Continuing Education, she also helped organize the Bloomfield Youth Guidance Committee.

## Oakland Remap Plan Challenged

As promised, Oakland County Democrats have filed a lawsuit against the Republican controlled apportionment commission charging "unconstitutional and inexcusable political gerrymandering."

The suit, filed in the Michigan Court of Appeals by Morley Wingard, chairman of the Oakland County Democratic Committee, orders the apportionment commission to show cause on or before April 14 why its plan should not be held invalid.

The lawsuit centers on claims that the 3-2 Republican dominated commission adopted a 31-district plan that ignores constitutional guidelines which require population equality among districts.

## Judge Adams Seeks Term

Probate Judge Donald E. Adams will seek his reelection to a six-year term on the Probate Court bench in the primary election. Judge Adams was first elected Judge of Probate in 1960.

He is chairman of the Oakland County Community Mental Health Services Board, on the executive committee for Camp Oakland, on the board of directors of the Pontiac Boys Club and a member of the Clinton Valley Council of Boy Scouts.

Adams is also president of the Children's Charter of the Courts of Michigan.

IN ADDITION to carrying a full court load, Judge Adams serves as senior probate judge with administrative responsibility for the probate, juvenile and mental health departments.

Previous to his election as Probate judge, he was justice of the peace in the Waterford Township for more than 20 years and has been an attorney since 1936.

## Old Ideas On TB Updated

"TB? Why, that's a thing of the past. No one gets TB anymore." "I can't possibly have TB. I've never felt better in my whole life." "Does this mean I'll have to go away to a sanatorium? What will happen to my family?"

Many Michigan citizens have grave misconceptions about tuberculosis, said John Pettibone, Lansing, president of the Michigan Tuberculosis and Respiratory Disease Association. They seem to fall into two categories; those who believe it is no longer possible to get TB, and those who think coming down with TB means an end to a useful and fulfilling life.

Tuberculosis is certainly not a disease of the past, Pettibone said. In our state in 1970 there were 1,431 new active cases reported and although this is about a 40 per cent decline over the number of cases reported just 10 years ago, it is still a substantial figure.
