eight years. Records kept by the MSC farm management department from 1535 to 1945 show that farmers made more money by having their farm businesses more efficient and lar-ger. Well operated large farms (averaging 244 tillable acress) paid the operator an average annual la-bor income of 34.76 while poorly operated farms only 'paid 81.074. Even small farms (averaging 56 acres) that were well operated paid an average annual labor in-come of \$1.500. This shows the value of efficient operation.
