(Continued from Page Two) was expressed by the Europeans over the possibility of a resumption of this Eastern-Western trade. In the course of this meeting and several others, we have had a chance to learn many more details of this complicated plan and its evolution that possibly can be reported here. And yet these meetings could reveal only tiny fragments of the tremendous amount of research, analysis, study and discussion which was reduced to a few salient points, and presented to committees of congress in Secretary of State Marshall's final report.

Secretary Marshall, himself, had to go through a long period of briefing. In his last news conference he met with congressional committee men, he had, as he put it, "immense ground to cover." And Washington, outside of the experts who sat in on the seminars, who knows more of the details of this plan which has been given his name.

Marshall Target of Press Critics I mentioned Secretary of State Marshall and his last news conference before meeting with the congressional committees. There has been growing criticism of Mr. Marshall here in Washington. It took form after the conference and has appeared in editorials.

But! In a democracy, if you are an official, you have to live in a goldfish bowl. The editorialist quoted the late Clinton Gilbert on Secretary of State, later Chief Justice Charles Evans Hughes. Gilbert, speaking of Hughes, said: "He talks to the country daily. He takes the people into his confidence, telling all that can be told, and as soon as it can be told. He makes no step without carrying the country with him. . . . That is democratic control of foreign relations.

Marshall, secretary of State, who described the "supreme underlying issue" as follows: "Whether or not men are to be left free to organize their existence in accordance with their own desires or whether they are to have their lives arranged and dictated for them by small groups of men who have arrogated to themselves this arbitrary power."

Our present foreign policy, thus championed on a bipartisan basis, offers risks that are virtually frightening. Should we take these risks? Can we avoid the danger of war regardless of what path we choose? Every citizen should weigh the evidence carefully and prayerfully. There is no escape. The hour of decision is again near.
