Bailey Gives Tips On Calf Care

milking during the first two days
following freshening is considered
an aid in preventing milk fever.
Catves should be taught to drink
from a pall when removed from the
cow, unless nipple palls are used.
They should be feed two to four
junts of whole milk daily the
first week, Bailey recommended.
The amount of milk can be increased gradually but it is best to
underfeed at the start.

At that time they should be well-started on good quality hay and grain concentrates. Feeding of milk should be discontinued by the time the calf is six months old. An abundance of pure water should be available to the calf at all times and one per cent of salt abuncance of pure water should be available to the calf at all times and one per cent of salt should be added to the grain mix ture.

Calves do not digest large quantities of hay or pasture until 16 to 12 months of age.
