4-H CLUBS SEEK GARDEN SEEDS FOR EUROPEANS

The 4-H Clubs of Michigan are doing something to help the people of Europe — it's a program that will help those people to help themselves.

Beginning now, 4-H Clubs are working to provide packages of vegetable seeds for hungry Europeans. The packages, while weighing only a little over two pounds, will produce up to five tons of vegetables. The seeds included are enough for a garden for a family of four and the selection was made by authorities on gardening. The program is conducted in cooperation with the American Seed Trade association.

Among the 24 vegetables included in the assortment are peas, beans, beets, carrots, onions, radishes, cabbage, cauliflower, cucumber, lettuce, tomato, turnips, and many others.

Twenty-three countries are listed for the donor to choose from. The assortment can be sent to an individual, to the Church World Service, Inc., or to the War Relief Service.

Local 4-H Clubs are organizing at the present time to solicit funds for the project. The cost of each package, delivered, is \$3.55. All orders must be in by February 25, so that full use can be made of seeds this year.
