SUE SUGDEN GAINS NATIONAL COMMENDATION

Sue Sugden, after having won regional recognition in the South-eastern Michigan Scholastic Writing Contest, sponsored by the Detroit News and Scholastic Magazine, for her book review of "Gentlemen's Agreement", received National commendation as well as an achievement key and a Webster's Collegiate Dictionary.

In the regional contest, 11,850 manuscripts were submitted, of which 164 merited honorable mention, and 120 deserved achievement keys and dictionaries. The 281 winning manuscripts were sent to New York for national judgment. Sue, along with the others, was presented her award Friday night, April 30, at the Rackham Memorial Auditorium, in Detroit.

For two successive years Farmington students have been honored for creative writing ability. Last year John Pettibone received honors in the Poetry Division. M.V.
