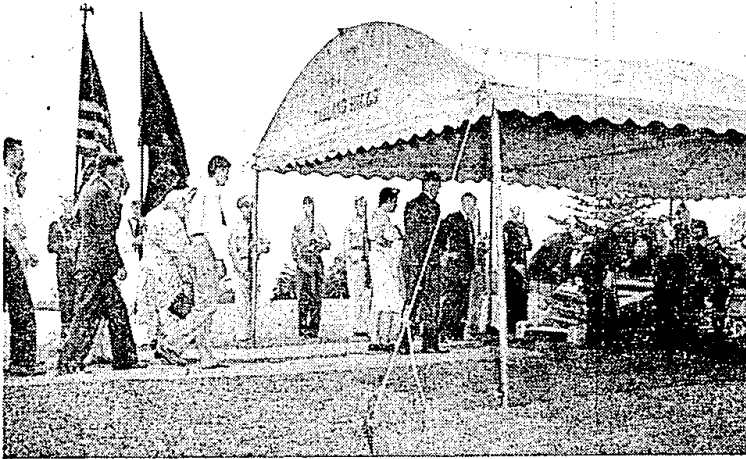
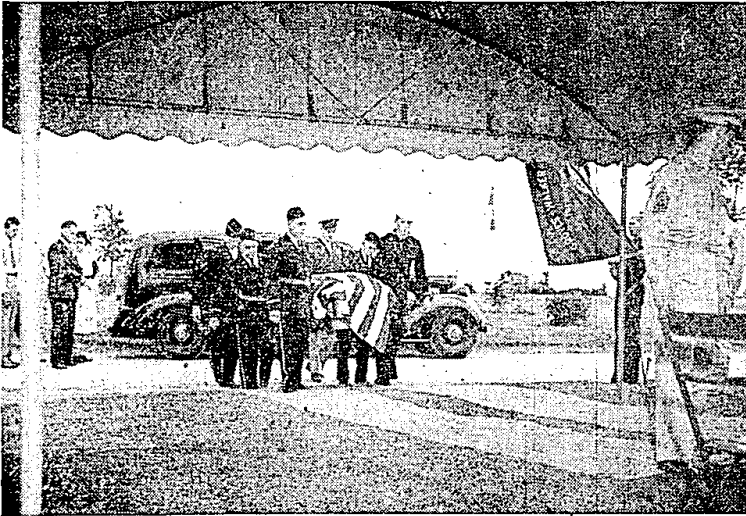


## Groves-Walker Post Officiating At Yarian Funeral
