I have quoted W. E. Woodward before. In his "New American History", he says:

Chemical Grass Control Sought

Because grasses, especially quack grass, are often a serious problem in horticultural crops, such as strawberries and other small fruits

in horticultural crops, such as strawberries and other small fruits, research specialists at Michigan State college have been seeking means of chemical control.

Teats have been carried on in the greenbouse by R. P. Carlson the greenbouse by R. P. Carlson meant of Horticulture, to fight in herbicide effective when applied to the foliage of grasses. They are making their results available at this time even though they are preliminary in nature, becques of the wide interest in grass killers and because each report is another step in progress.

Water-soluble compounds with long names such as trichroacetic acid (referred to as TCA) and sammonium thiocyanate, as well as Herbicide "PB", were aprayed on the grasses. Applications were made at various stages of growth from the time of planting until the grasses were a foot tail.

Results showed that approximat-

Results showed that approximately 150 to 200 pounds per acre of the ammonium saits of TCA were required for a complete kill of well established grass. The leaves gradually changed in-color from a light green to a dark green, and after four weeks they withered.
