Bailey Gives Tips On Hessian Fly

A warning about the Hessian fly, the insect that attacks wheat in the fall and spring, was given this week by Karl D. Balley, county agricultural agent.

In this area, planting wheat before September 20 is dangerous. This date was established as best for this area by Michigan State college specialists who set wheat seeding dates which avoid danage by the Hessian fly.

Karl Bailey Issues Specialists Urges Check New Spray Report

New Spray Report

Frown rot is already showing up, according to county peach growers, and this disease can be a serious by roblem, Karl D. Balley, Oakland County agricultural agent, and nounced this week. Here is a new recommendation from Michigan State College Experiment Station.

It is suggested that liquid line sulphur, 2 quarts to 100 gallons, be used now in place of milder fungificates. This material applied 5 to 7 days before harvest is claimed to be most effective in controlled Brown Rot quarter from the user of liquid lime sulphur on peaches if the manterial is used in the strongth suggested above and the trees are sprayed with a for rather than a course stream.

Late blight has been found npotatoes and tomatoes in some southeastern counties in Michigan. From now until harvest, it can normally be expected that weather will be increasingly favorable for the development and spread of late blights.

The Gollowing recommendations

The following recommendations are designed to prevent infection of late blight:
Potatoes: Spray once a week until harvest with bordeaux (SP 100), or fixed copper (2 pounds metallic capper per 100 gallons water).

Partata to Dhanea According to manufacturer's recommendations. If late blight occurs in the field, spray every 4 to 5 days.

Tomatoes: Spray once a week with one of the fixed copper per 100 gallons of water or with a carbamate like Partata or Dithanea according to manufacturer's recommendations. If late blight appears in the field, spray every 4 to 5 days.

Copper dusts should contain 7 per cent copper and carbamate dusts 10 per cent active ingredient.


