New Scap-Making Method Worldwide shortages of fats and oils could have Scape production replained by Scape production to the scape have been for technical developments by scientists in the scape industry. The backbone of this streamlined soap makins, method is an ingenious piece of equipment called the "hydrolyzer." It is a stainless steel tube about the diameter of a barrel, towering to the height of an eight-story building. Fats and oils under high pressure are pumped in at the bottom of the tube, and scalding hot water, also under pressure, enters at the top.
