A word of caution about pasturing frosted Sudan grass and alfalfa was given this week by A. C. Balter, extension dalryman at Michigan State college.

Baltzer points out that it has always been considered wise not to jasture either frosted Sudan grass or alfalfa. Not only does the danger of bloot exist with both, but with Sudan grass, the hazard of poisoning exists. Chemists have repeatedly found Sudan grass to carry a heavy prussic acid content both when immature and following freezing weather.


