Farm Plowing Time Can Be Fall Or Spring

The old question of fall plowing versus spring plowing is again making the rounds. Both methods have their advantages, says Paul Rood, Michigan State College soils

Rood, Michigan State College soils specialist.
Fall plowing, if it is the method chosen, should be done very late in the fall, he points out. It's risky to fall plow land with much of a slope because of crosion. The protection of a crop is destroyed by fall plowing and wind and water erosion can take place.
On the credit side of the ledger, fall plowing permits early planting in the spring of such crops as sugar beets, outs and barley and is beneficial to the soil structure.


