about completed. about completed. Republican legislators have whit-tied Governor Williams' \$343 mil-lion dollar budget to around \$260 millions. As anticipated revenue will total \$235 millions, a deficit of \$20 to \$25 millions is thus in licit.

The role of the state as a tax collector for local governments was augmented by the constitutional sales tax diversion amendment. Under this amendment, twice ap-proved by the voters, the state di-verts 75 per cent of the sales tax revenues to local governments.
