## Final Ratings

The clock had to be splashing Farmington's way. Farmington Harrison and North Farmington High Schools captured top billing in the All-Observer prep swimming selections.

Harrison and North each placed two individuals on the first team and each stole the show in the relay department, with Harrison sporting the No. 1 200 medley squad and North the top 400 freestyle relay team.

It was far from being an all-senior show in the nine individual slots and two relay berths for a 17-man total first team.

The juniors made an impressive mark with five on the first team and coupled with two sophomores, gave the seniors a real splash for the talent honors.

Redford Union's senior Tom Stolkey captured the top berth in the 200 freestyle.

The 5-10, 145-pounder had the fastest time in the Observerland area in the 200 with a 1:50.2 and was captain of the Suburban Eight RU squad.

In '71, Tom received the most improved underclassman award at RU and this season captured the squad's MVP. Stolkey set a school varsity record in the 200 freestyle (1:50.3), the 100 freestyle (1:49.9), the 100 but-

terly (:56.2), the 200 individual medley (2:09.2) and tied the 100 breaststroke record at 1:01.6.

The solo All-Stater in Observerland was a show-in for the 200 yard individual medley.

Harrison's "Mr. Everything," Mike Rado, clocked in at 2:00.7, tops in the state.

Rado is a six-time conference champion and is listed in all events in the Observerland listings except diving, 100 freestyle and 100 breaststroke.

The 6-0, 170 pound junior captured All-American honors.

In the 50 yard freestyle, Dale Swezene of Garden City East was top choice with a :22.5 time, No. 1 in Observerland.

The 6-4, 175-pound junior swims the 100 freestyle, 100 breaststroke and both relays in addition to the 30 freestyle.

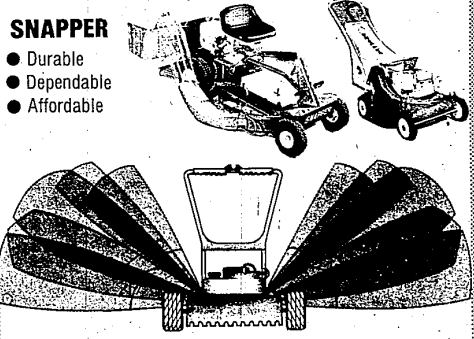
North Farmington's 400 freestyle relay squad finished No. 1 in Observerland ratings and fourth in the state with a time of 3:22.8.
