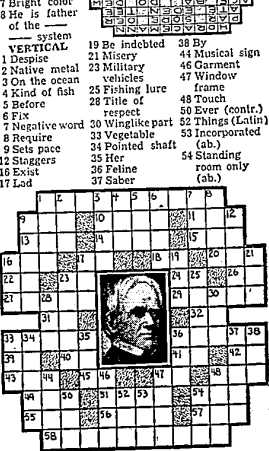

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Philippines Get River Of Milk

A river of milk flows in the tropical Philippines islands. In secondary schools and colleges, from Aparri in North Luzon to Mindanao in the south, Filipino kids line up at milk time and receive their portions of milk. Only it isn't always liquid. Most of the children prefer to have the powder dry, mixed in their cups with sugar, and eaten like candy. It isn't exactly conventional, but it puts the milk into the children. The people who have donated the milk want it that way if the children do.

Who donated the milk? The government? No, but the farmers' organization that calls itself CROP, short for Christian Rural Overseas Program, an American outfit which is helping rural folks in America to do what they can to ease hunger and undernourishment abroad.

The last shipment of 25,000 pounds of CROP powdered milk, which reached Manila in May, is being distributed in the Philippines by church agencies. They do not limit their charitable work to any special sect or faith, but distribute CROP relief supplies wherever they are needed.

School principals submit lists of undernourished children throughout the islands. If these are backed by doctor's certificates, drums of powdered milk are sent. The schools carry on the actual feeding themselves and supply the sugar. Sugar is considered an indispensable adjunct of milk in the Philippines, which is a sugar-producing country.

CROP, by special arrangement, exchanged the original stocks of skimmed milk, contributed by American dairy farmers, for powdered milk, in deference to the preference of the Philippines and also because the tropical climate does not permit the storage of evaporated or other forms of liquid milk.

Powder is the most important part of the CWS program in the Philippines. Of this, 50 per cent is supplied to CWS through CROP. Political dissident activities, disastrous typhoons and storms, have displaced masses of farm people. These need to be fed. To aid the mass feeding program in the Philippines, CROP sent last year 660 sacks of beans, 500 sacks of wheat, corn and 60 cases of evaporated milk, among other commodities.

In the typhoon-struck Visayas where a strong hurricane wreaked devastation in November of 1949, CROP beans are still being distributed to maintain the lives of victims. If reconstruction is further hampered, church relief agencies in the Philippines may have to concentrate even further on food distribution.

Approve 20-Day Season For U. P. Grouse

With all signs pointing to improved rutted grouse shooting next fall, the conservation commission has approved a 20-day season — October 1 to 20 inclusive — in the upper peninsula; a 22-day season — October 15 to November 5 inclusive — below the Straits. Bag limits will be five a day, 10 in possession, 25 in season.

Drummond, Bois Blanc and Beaver Islands, where the conservation department has released birds in recent years, will be closed to that way if the children do.

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
