TRAFFIC FATALITIES OUTNUMBER DEATHS OF ALL U. S. WARS

The nation's military deaths in all wars since 1775 had reached a total of about 1,055,600 at the end of two years of war in Korea, which approximately 12,500 American combat deaths have occurred since the invasion of South Korea on June 25, 1950, the Association of Casualty and Surety Companies estimated today.

The Association's continuing comparative study of war and traffic deaths showed, however, that the total of highway fatalities since the first automobile accident victim was killed in New York City 52 years and nine months ago is now far ahead of the all-time war toll. Since February, when the total of lives lost in highway accidents equaled military fatalities for the first time, the historical toll of 1,018,500 traffic deaths has surpassed 15,000 above the nation's war fatality toll of 1,055,600.

In the four months since the automobile outpaced war as a killer, highway deaths have climbed 6,800. This is more than 10 times greater than the increase of 600 in the number of American lives lost in Korean fighting with the trace tolls being held at Panmunjom during the same period.

With the automobile now far outpacing war as a killer, the Association said, there is little likelihood that military casualties will ever overtake highway fatalities in the grim race between the two killers, even if military forces were to be destroyed wholesale in any future fighting.

MEASURE WATER, CEMENT FOR BEST CONCRETE WORK

Water and cement must be accurately measured to insure uniform strength, reports a building expert for the cement industry.

With small mixtures first put in the measured amount of water, next add part of the gravel. Add this gravel to the water before cement is added will prevent a weak concrete also. The cement is added next and then the sand and gravel. The concrete is "struck off" carefully just after it is placed in the forms. This removes lumps and bubbles leaving a true, even surface for the final trowelling operation. Further finishing is delayed until the concrete is quite stiff. First finishing is done with a wood float which gives a uniform, gritty surface. For side walks, floors where a nonskid surface is required this wood float is used. This should be applied with a smooth finish. The wood float is used with a steel trowel. The use of the steel trowel before the mix has set will cause the concrete to shrink and likely to produce surface cracks or develop numerous fine cracks.

A scored surface is sometimes produced by scoring the concrete before it has hardened thoroughly. The desirable properties of concrete - water-tightness, durability and strength - increase as the surface is so long as moisture is present and favorable temperatures prevail. Concrete which is kept moist for seven days is about 60 per cent stronger than that which is kept in dry air the entire period. Coagulative moist curing, especially in the early stages, aids in securing a hard, dense surface and in preventing cracking and dusting.

Floors or other horizontal surfaces may be protected by a covering of earth, straw or burlap and the covering kept moist by sprinkling for at least five days. When a covering is not used, the surface can be flooded with water or kept moist by continuous sprinkling. Avoid alternate wetting and drying.

Wayne U. Professor Works At Oak Ridge

Assistant Professor Samuel Conant of the Wayne University mathematics department has been appointed to do research this summer at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory, the nation's largest atomic energy research center.

Professor Conant is participating in the summer program. Professor Conant left Detroit early in June and expects to remain at Oak Ridge until September.
