SCHOOL OPENING BRINGS ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC HAZARDS

With the reopening of schools and nearly one and one-half million Michigan children crossing streets and highways on their way to and from classrooms, Sergeant Henry P. Kozowicz, commander of the Detroit State Police Post, is urging all persons to take part in the current state wide child safety campaign.

"Last year," Sergeant Kozowicz said, "8,247 children under 15 years of age were killed or injured in Michigan traffic, an average of about 160 casualties each week."

"More often than not the children were victims of their own carelessness, but many of the tragedies could have been avoided if drivers had been more alert and expecting the unexpected."

"Drivers should take special precautions, not only in school and playground areas, but in all areas where children are likely to be. They also should always remember that thousands of pre-school age children will be outdoors during all hours of the day. In other words, children may be anywhere, anytime."

"Likewise, adult pedestrians, parents especially, can help prevent accidents involving children by practicing safe walking habits. Adults should realize that their own actions are examples boys and girls observe and follow. Too often these are examples of carelessness."

"Help protect children. For their sake - as well as your own - walk and drive carefully."
