### Harry Lapham Attends Two Week Bank Course

Harry L. Lapham, Farmington State Bank, was among the 691 students from 31 states who have just completed a two-week residence session at the School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin at Madison.

The school, sponsored by the Central States Conference consisting of the bankers associations of 16 states, requires residence attendance for two weeks each year for three years for graduation. A total of 205 seniors from 27 states received their diplomas at the school's 1952 graduation exercises Friday night, September 5.

Attendance at the 1952 School of Banking enabled its students at Wisconsin's State University not only to meet a large number of bankers from all over the country, but they also had the opportunity of hearing the school's distinguished lecturers, this year 103 experts from all parts of the nation, who are recognized authorities in banking, economics, law and industrial, and agricultural and financial problems.

### Dutch Elm Disease Spreading To Michigan

The lethal Dutch elm disease, which destroys the trees it infects, has been found in Sterling Moore state park and Island Lake recreation area, the conservation department reports.

The disease is believed spreading westward through southeastern Michigan, carried by the elm bark beetle.

Best control measure is to cut out and destroy infested trees.

### RESIDENTS PAY 93% OF CITY TAXES BEFORE DEADLINE

A total of 93% of the city's personal and property taxes were paid up to September 2, deadline date, Kathryn Cotter, City Treasurer, reported.

September 2 was the final date for the payment of taxes without penalty. Delinquent taxes now have a 2% additional charge attached which will remain until November 1. After that date, a 4% penalty will be added to the original tax. Property owners will be able to pay their taxes up to March 1 with the 4% penalty added. After the March 1 date the tax rolls will go to the county office and city taxes will have to be paid to the County Treasurer in Pontiac.

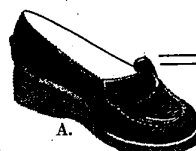

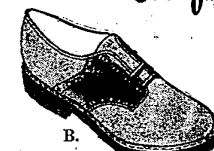

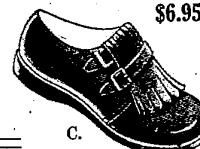
