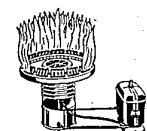

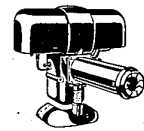

**SERIES OF BIBLE
SERMONS PLANNED
BY DR. ADAMS**

One of the most important events in the religious history of the century is destined to take place this month.

On September 30, the new complete Revised Standard Version of the Holy Bible will be published. This stupendous work, on which the best Protestant scholars of modern times have collaborated, is the Bible in up-to-date language. Obscure, old-fashioned phrases have been eliminated but all the majestic beauty of the 341-year-old King James Version has been retained.

The true meaning of many passages, the publishers say, will now be clear to thousands of readers for the first time.

Anticipating the publication of the new version, three sermons about the Bible are being given by Dr. Frank D. Adams, pastor of the Farmington Universalist Church, who is a Greek scholar conversant with biblical history.

The first of these, "The Bible and Holy Scripture," was preached last Sunday. The second, "Some Riches of the Bible," will be given this Sunday and the third, "Cain and Able: Beginning of Hate and Violence," on September 28.

"All these," Dr. Adams explained, "are to be based upon our knowledge and use of the Bible in the light of present-day learning and interpretation."

"The aim is to inculcate a correct understanding of the Bible and its origin, to stimulate more reading of the Bible and application of its teachings in these difficult times."

These sermons are being given at 11 a.m. in the beautifully remodeled sanctuary of the church at Warner and Thomas Streets. The new pipe organ is now in use and enhances the beauty of the service.

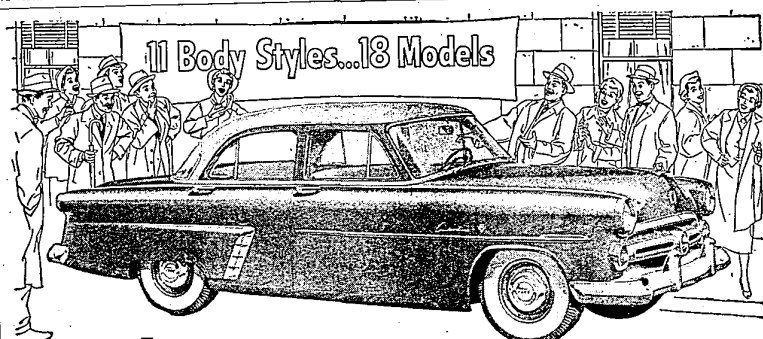
