due to the liberalization of basic science and medical practice requirements in 1952. The new laws permit doctors from foreign countries to practice in Michigan on a one-year license while they are becoming U. S. citizens.

"While we still don't have a doctor for every community," says William J. Burns, executive secretary of the Michigan State Medical Society, "we have gained several hundred practitioners in the last year."

Michigan's civil defense corps officially has accepted defeat to its once extensive plans for the defense of the state.

Last year the department asked for \$3,000,000. It got \$183,778 from economy-minded legislators. It was a blow, but Brig. Gen. Lester J. Matland, civil defense director, with army colonel, scrapped extensive plans and concentrated on cutting down his staff.

This year budget drafters report he is asking for only \$730,782 for 1953-54 to "maintain a nucleus organization of workers."

After his elaborate plans and preparedness schedules had been scuttled, Matland was forced to telescope his activities into purely administrative functions.

"Another year with a sizeable budget and staff would have gotten the program rolling..." he said. But he says his present staff of 18 employees in the cut-throat can handle extension of the corps if disaster strikes, with the addition of a few key workers.

**FORT CUSTER VA HOSPITAL MANAGER CITES NEED FOR ADDITIONAL WORKERS**

Forty hospital aides are needed at Fort Custer, Michigan, Veterans Administration Hospital, Dr. Ernest F. Jones, manager, said today.

This hospital cares for and treats the mentally ill veteran patients, Dr. Jones explained, and the need for hospital aides to assist in this work continues to be urgent.

Starting salary for aides is \$2500.00 a year for a forty-hour week, with promotion possibilities of up to \$2750.00 per year after three months' service. Quarters and meals are available on the hospital grounds for a limited number of single men.

Employees earn from 13 to 26 days per year vacation time, depending on length of service, and all employees earn 13 days per year sick leave. Age limit for non-veterans is 18 to 62, for veterans there are no age limits. Applicants must be able to read and write. Cost of travel to hospital for interview and physical examination must be borne by applicant. All appointments will be made under Federal Civil Service.

It is a steady job with no layoffs. Recreation facilities are available on the station, and major sports of every kind are close at hand in nearby Detroit and Chicago.
