# Unity Opens Livonia Center

Unity of Livonia, a congregation with a new name, moves into a new sanctuary with services at 11 a.m. Sunday, May 6.

The congregation which, as Unity of West Suburbia, formerly occupied a building on Curtis Avenue in Livonia and for several months has been meeting in Claremontville High, has invited the public to help dedicate its new home at 28660 Five Mile.

An open house from 12 noon to 1:30 p.m. will follow the services.

The new Unity Center is located at Harrison and Five Mile, and members and visitors may park at the Livonia-5 plaza or the lot on the corner of Harrison and Five Mile since the church parking lot has not yet been completed.

The Rev. Gene Sorensen, who came to serve the local church just before building began last summer, said the new sanctuary has seats for 240. There also are facilities for about 100 children in the Sunday school and a growing metropolitan book library.

"Attendance has increased so we now are averaging 210 worshippers on Sundays," Rev. Sorensen said. "We may soon have to go to two services."

The Livonia church began in May 1962 under the leadership of the Rev. Diane Seaman. Sunday services were held

Unity is a church and a school of practical Christianity with headquarters in Lee Summit, Mo.

Under the leadership of her successor, the Rev. Marilyn White, the growing congregation purchased the 3½ acres on Five Mile.

Rev. Sorensen took over duties here in June 1972, after serving ministries in Fort Worth, Shreveport, La., Ventura, Calif., and Los Angeles.

The decision was made in recent months to change the congregation's name to Unity of Livonia.
