

# 'Ridge' Puts On Carnival Dress

The first "Gaslite Festival" on the Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College will feature carnival rides, musical entertainment and a Mother's Day breakfast this weekend, May 11 to 13.

The campus is located at 1-696 and Orchard Lake Rd., Farmington. Festival hours are from 2 p.m. until 12 midnight Friday; 11 a.m. until 12 midnight Saturday and 10 a.m. until 10 p.m. on Sunday.

Came booths, educational exhibits and an open house are among the planned activities.

The festival is the first in Orchard Ridge's six-year history of serving Oakland County residents, particularly those from Farmington and Southfield.

Artwork will be displayed, demonstrated and sold during the festival, and the science department will feature an ecology display where people can buy trees to be planted on the campus.

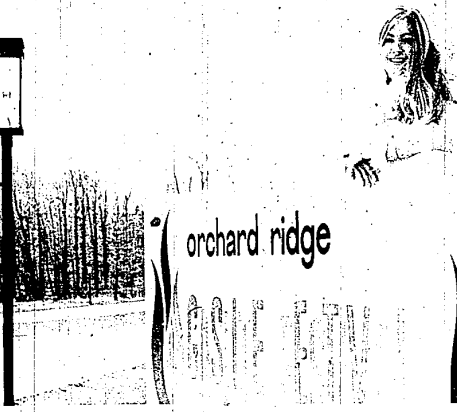
