

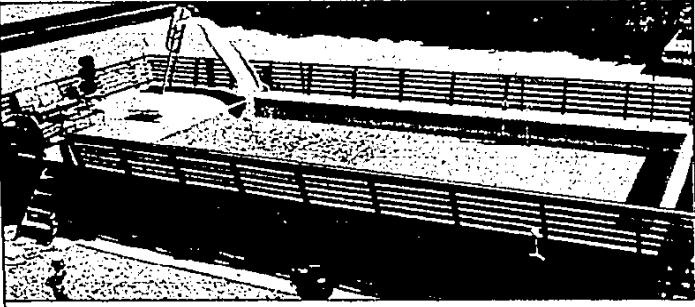

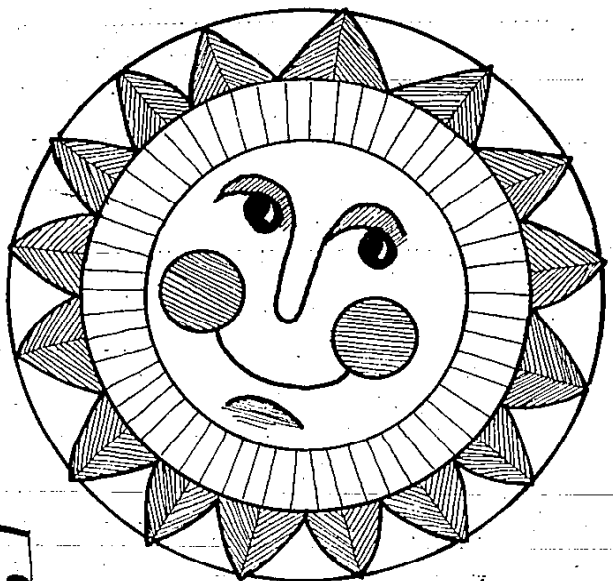
Little darling, the smiles returning to their faces,
