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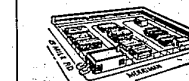

Michigan Fish Division Experts Cite Need For Long Range Plans

Despite what equipment advertisements and fishing guide books maintain, there are those among the angling fraternity who will tell you all the answers to fishing success aren't kept locked in a lure box.

A group of these mild dissenters is found in the conservation department's fish division, whose major aim it is to provide better fishing for Michigan anglers.

The group would like nothing better than to make saints of all confirmed angling sinners by providing such good fishing that there's no reason for exaggeration. The trouble is, old Ma Nature doesn't give up her bag of wildlife tricks just to satisfy human whimsy. And fish division workers are first to admit they don't have all the answers to angling problems in Michigan.

How far should Michigan go, for example, in trying to better fishing by suggesting removal of weeds from a particular lake? Which of those weeds is necessary in starting the long "food chain" that ultimately ends with the prize walleye in the skillet?

Or, suppose one type of fish is stocked in a lake where before it was absent, this being done without prior cautious research. "Do we endanger the natural balance so fishing may actually be harmed instead of helped? Again, with no two lakes quite alike, can we take things we've learned about lake A and apply them to lake B or is this too risky?"

Answers to such questions have been slow in coming; time-consuming research must be completed before active management plans dare be applied.

The fish division has for many years been developing a two-sided program for angling improvement. The short-range programs, including "put and take" trout plantings, shelter installation, lake mapping, warm water species replacement or removal and a number of other projects have been instituted to give immediate results. The longer-range programs, such as the over-all research and management projects, protracted watershed improvement and fishing site acquisition and development, will give more active results in years to come.

Department employees are going ahead with a number of other projects, too, all within the framework of fish division policy, but they emphasize that time, money and patience are needed if all this work is to be effective.
