Dick Grimshaw, winning the 100 yard and 220 dash events, was high scorer for Farmington with 11 1/2 points, followed by Roger Goers with 10 1/2 points. Phillips of Van Dyke led the scoring in the meet with 15 points.

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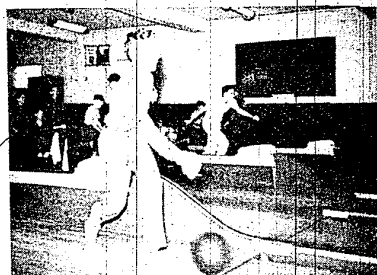
