"Professional organizations of which he is a member include the Optimist Club, Real Estate Board, and Society of Residential Appraisers."

"Water, sewers, rubbish disposal and extreme hot road conditions are listed by Ridgway as major problems confronting township officials. Ingle, 33, is married and the father of one son, Allen C., Jr., 3. He owns his home with his family at 2134 Turlington. Ingle has been a resident of Farmington Township for the past two years and lived in the City of Farmington for four years prior to that time.

Ingle is a college graduate in law and accounting. He is a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion and attends the Clarenceville Methodist Church.
