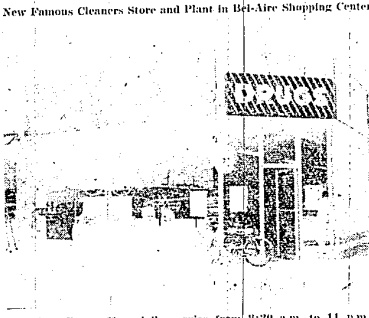

CITY TAX RATE HUMPS ONE MILL IN 25 YEARS

According to city officials, the tax rate has increased only one mill in the past 25 years, although the operating budget has increased about 600%.

An examination of the records show that in 1929 the city tax rate was 16 mills on an assessed valuation of \$2,632,739. In that year the operating budget was \$15,416,32. At the present time the city tax rate is 17 mills on an assessed valuation of \$5,288,310. The operating budget for the year 1955-56 has been set at \$26,757,777.

During the 25-year period such services as weekly rubbish and garbage collection, snow removal and daily street sweeping in the business area have been established. In control in the police department has been increased 3 1/2 times while public works personnel has been increased 2 1/2 times, and the office staff has been increased 3 times. Police and public works equipment has been increased in value approximately 12 times since 1930.

Developer Agrees

Green had signed the agreement with the City and that he should live up to it. The agreement calls for the establishing of a uniform sloping grade from the rear of the houses along the southern portion of the subdivision to an easement at the property line adjacent to the Shilawasse Street property. Green stated that adherence to the plan would necessitate the withdrawal of three homes from P. H. A. because the grading would not conform to their specifications.

Following agreement on the grading plan, Green requested that the City lift its ban on the issuance of occupancy permits on those homes where the grading is not a major problem. He also suggested that the house being purchased by Harry Locke, located north of the lot, be released as an emergency circumstance. Green offered to hold up occupancy requests on two other houses if the Council would agree to the plan.

The Council stated that if Green completed the grading this week, the inspection could be made over the week end and the ban could be lifted next Monday.


