So far, Conservation Department surveys indicate Michigan is headed for another bumper pheasant crop. An early hatch has given the birds a good start this year and nesting was reported as generally successful.

Junior League Baseball Program Will Conclude With Movie, Field Day

The Junior League, the first of the three divisions of the Farmington Baseball for Boys groups, will hold a hot dog roast and field day on Saturday, August 6, starting at 5 p.m. and continuing until 8 p.m. The event will conclude activities of the Junior League for this year.

All team members, coaches and officials of the league are invited to take part in the program.

At 2 p.m. the boys will be treated to a special matinee at the Civic Theatre, thanks to the generosity of Manager Ed Huhler. From there the boys will go directly to the City Park for the picnic.

Food, pop and ice cream will be free. Boys will participate in a variety of field games and worthwhile prizes will be awarded to the winners. A sports movie will be shown.

Hollis Hoard, a local photographer, has offered to take pictures of all the boys in the league. Members are therefore asked to wear their team hats and jerseys.

Due to the large number of boys reporting out for the summer baseball program in Farmington last spring, it was decided to set up a Junior Division for boys not chosen to play on Little League teams. Twelve teams were thus set up and divided into "A", "B" and "C" groups. The "A" and "B" groups each played a full schedule of 12 games while the "C" group, under the eye of four directors, learned fundamentals of baseball the first half of the season and played regularly scheduled games the second half. In this group were approximately 70 boys who were trying out for organized baseball play for the first time.

Games in the "A" group were played each Tuesday and Thursday. Team 7, coached by Joe Upleger and John Hahn, emerged as champs. In the "B" group, Team 1 and Team 2 ended the regular season in a tie, necessitating a playoff. Team 2, coached by Bob Benedict and E. J. Klaba, took a 5-3 decision for the championship.
