A parcel of land being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 24, T. 1 N., R. 9 E., Farmington Township, Oakland County, Michigan, commencing with the Northwest Corner, Section 3, Livonia Township, Wayne County, T. 1 S., R. 9 E., and proceeding thence 89° 33' 40" e. 59.19 feet to the point of beginning, thence due North 1260 feet, thence along an arc convex to the Northeast with a radius of 1200 feet and an arc length of 1388.75 feet, then along a chord having a bearing of South 27° 52' 12" thence North 89° 32' 40" e. 718.75 feet, thence South 0° 30' E. 292.20 feet, thence North 89° 33' 40" W. 2003.18 feet to the point of beginning.

It is further resolved that within 10 days from date hereof public notice shall be given of this intent to amend the zoning Ordinance of Farmington Township, Oakland County, Michigan, by the publication of the notice of such intent in the Farmington Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in Farmington Township, Oakland County, Michigan.

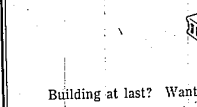
