WHALES ONCE SWAM IN GREAT LAKES, GEOLOGIST CLAIMS

Ti may come as a surprise to Mi-chigan land lubbers to learn that whales once cavorted in the Great Lakes. Russell C. Hussey, professor of geology at the University of Mich-igan, points out that whale skele-tons have been found in the Lower Peninsula

And in case you think this is just a tall tale about "the big one that got away," several finds have been made.
