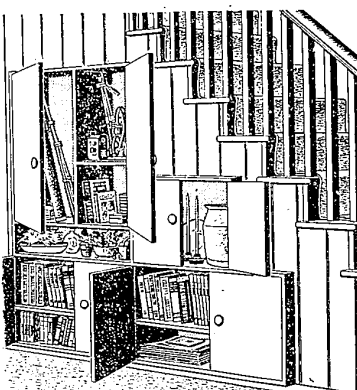

### Bulbs of Plants Must Be Taken Up, Protected From Killing Winter Frost

When killing frost begins, it will usually be large bulbs (or corms) each with remains of the original bulb attached below, to which you prefer to be exact, the gladioli, dahlias, begonias and other tender flowers which blossomed in your garden, you will probably find them in good condition and larger than they were a few weeks previous. Fall weather makes them plump with food stored for next year's flowers.

The ground would be a fine place for them to pass the winter, except that hard freezing probably would be fatal. To carry them over safely you must protect them from freezing, but keep them cool so they do not sprout prematurely or dry out and wither. After digging let them dry in the sun if the temperature stays above freezing. Dry soil will shake from them easily. The stem of a begonia tuber should not be cut or broken off, but allowed to remain until it comes loose.

Both begonias and dahlias keep well when stored in a temperature from 40 to 60 degrees, and packed so air can circulate around them freely. Begonias may be stored in seed flats or similar shallow boxes, without lids, laid in dry peat moss. Gladioli keep well in similar boxes without the moss. Do not pile either several layers deep, as this may cause them to heat. Good ventilation is required. When gladioli are dug there may be small spots of infection which admit and absorb moisture. Occasional inspection should be made during the winter so that diseased tubers may be discarded.

### Home Accidents Take Heavy Toll In U. S. Each Year

Disabling accidents in the home are now occurring at the rate of 5 million per year, at an annual cost of more than a billion dollars to American families.

This was the meaning of the facts revealed in a nationwide accident survey whose detailed findings set the framework for a recent New York conference on home safety.

The findings of the survey, one year in the making and based on family interviews conducted throughout the United States, were made public by the Institute For Safer Living of the American Mutual Liability Insurance Company.

The number of people who are killed or injured in home accidents is reaching alarming proportions. Home accidents are four times as frequent as those occurring on the highway, three times as many as those happening in industry and 24 times the number happening in public.

The billion dollar tab for these accidents covered such matters as insurance payments, medication, doctor calls, nursing care and loss of time from work. Much of the present home accident situation centers on the growing Do-it-Yourself movement now estimated as the cause of more than 600,000 disabling home accidents per year.

On an overall basis, accidents occurring in the home represent the overwhelming part of the total. Yet, when compared with the problem of controlling highway, industrial and public accidents, our home situation receives by far the least amount of attention. While a great many safety and civic organizations are now doing effective work in the home field, there is an urgent need for more effective coordination of effort among all such agencies before the annual five million injury figure can be reduced or even kept from trending upward.

All concerned must devise better means of getting over to the public the seriousness of home hazards and the importance of safer methods of living. Improvement in the design and manufacture of safe homes and safe home equipment will influence home accident reduction. Acceptance by the individual family of its responsibility for the safety education of its members, however, is fundamental.

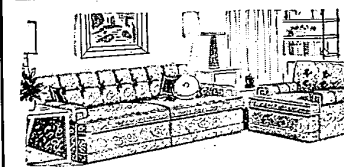

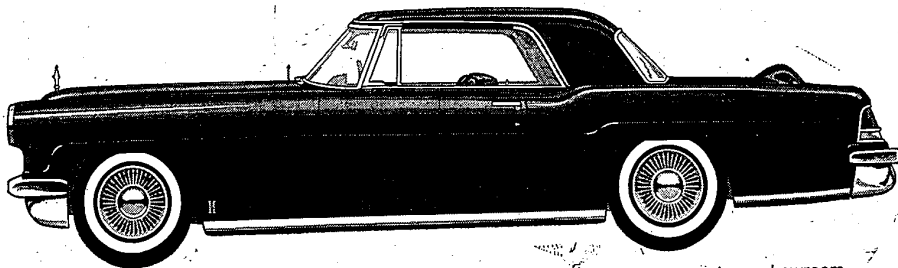
