

TRUCKING ASSOCIATION FINDS NIGHT DRIVING REQUIRES EXTRA PRECAUTIONS

Anyone who thinks night driving is better because there is less traffic is dead wrong, declared I. R. Rabilly, newly-elected president of the Michigan Trucking Association.

Records show that the night-trucking rate is approximately three times the daytime rate. At the time when days are growing shorter and nights longer, Michigan trucking industry has chosen "Night Driving" as the theme of its October Courtesy and Safety Program, Rabilly stated.

The truck driver is widely regarded as the most experienced of night drivers — which we think he is. He has to drive at night to bring you the things you eat, wear and use. And he has to drive safely. Set forth below are some of the rules of safe night driving which he follows.

- 1. Check lights each time before starting a drive at night. Replace burned-out bulbs or sealed-beam units immediately. Be sure the lights are clean.
2. Clean the outside of the windshield as often as necessary and clear the inside at least once a week.
3. Dusk is the most dangerous time of day. Turn on the lights early so others can see you. Don't use high beam headlights in an attempt to get more light on the road at dusk. It causes unnecessary glare.
4. Dim lights when within 500 feet of approaching traffic. In level country, headlight glare may be troublesome at even greater distances.

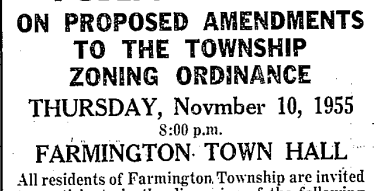
