The best weapon against the disease is the chest x-ray and less than one-tifth of Michigan's population is screened through all known chest x-ray programs. Free chest x-rays are available to everyone in the metropolitan area.

Plans are now sunder way by state and voluntary health agencies to step up the chest x-ray program so that more people will be screened and additional cases of TB taken out of the communitarier were 3.745 new cases of TB found and 303 people died with the disease.


