Nearly All Schools Join Special Milk Program

More than twice as many Michigan schools are participating now, than a year ago, in the nation's special milk program for schools. There are over 3,100 Michigan schools enrolled now, representing 90 to 95 per cent of the eligible school children.

The four statistics were released by Professor Dale E. Butz, Michigan State University, at the 16th annual Dairy Manufacturers Conference at MSU.

Last year, the 1,571 participating schools included 342,730 students, who consumed 15,950,000 half-pints of milk.

Pork, Beef Remain Good Meat Buys

Hearty appetites can be easily satisfied with the variety of economical meat cuts offered the shopper this week.

Although a few pork cuts have advanced on the wholesale market, shoppers will find retail prices for the week's offerings. Both smoked and canned hams vie for attention as the near holiday approaches. Center cut pork chops, prepared as extravagant cut, are priced at a seasonal low for elegant eating. Loin roast, Boston butt, spareribs, bacon, sausage, and the popular picnic cut wear low to medium prices.

Top grades of beef are in good supply, and the market on fed cattle has dropped slightly. Some retailers have lowered prices of round, sirloin, and T-bone steaks as much as ten cents per pound.

With many other meats in the limelight, fryer prices offer competition for the shopper's choice. Fryers serving 1 1/3 portions per pound rate high among the nutritious, economical protein foods. There are plenty of hen turkeys now selling at reasonable prices.

Increasing supplies are responsible for the decrease in egg prices. Medium-sizes are most ample, and represent the wisest egg choice.

Each day brings bigger and better supplies of citrus fruits to the counters. Most of the juice oranges are about 30 to 40 cents per dozen for the 216 size. Cortland, Jonathan, McIntosh, Spy, Red and Golden Delicious apples offer a wide variety of uses at 13 to 26 cents per pound. Grapes, cranberries, and bananas are seasonal fruits for fall meals.

Irish and sweet potatoes, squash, dry onions, and cabbage are penny-savers at the vegetable counter. Head lettuce and celery prices have decreased slightly, and shoppers will find plenty of green broccoli and Brussels sprouts at reasonable prices.

MILLIONS OF YOUNG TREES PLANTED IN MICHIGAN FORESTS

Conservation Department field crews planted 4,750,000 young trees on public lands in northern Michigan this fall.

Plantings in upper peninsula forests totaled 1,750,000 trees, while 3,000,000 were set out in the northern lower peninsula. Another 500,000 trees will go into the ground in the spring to complete the fiscal year schedule.

The Department's field administration division loaned tractors, drivers and transportation to help forestry crews complete the huge job before winter.

The fall's work is the first large block carved out of a proposed 250,000-acre program of planting 200,000,000 trees on public-owned lands in northern Michigan during coming years. Yearly plantings will be stepped up as the program gets into full swing.

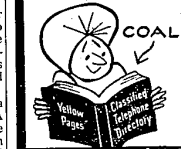

Textiles Authority Offers Suggestions On Wise Purchasing Of Bath Towels

Pulling and tugging seems to be part of life for every Turkish towel and washcloth. Because of this, homemakers should choose durable towels that can take the strain of family use and frequent laundering.

Along with being durable, Cecilia Roach, instructor in textiles, clothing and related arts at Michigan State University, declares that towels should also be absorbent.

The purchaser can feel how absorbent a towel is by the loops. They increase the surface area and thereby the amount of moisture the towel can absorb. The loops, or pile, should be thickly packed and about 1/8 inch long.



'Delayed' Light Switch On Market

A new delayed-action light switch is now available through local merchants. Looking very much like an ordinary switch, the new device snaps on in the same way, but features delayed action so that when the toggle is snapped to the "off" position the light remains on for approximately one minute.

Separate snaps are turned off when the switch is hinged one to the position labeled "delay" and the second one when the light actually goes out. There is time to walk about 75 feet before darkness. The action is entirely automatic.

The delayed action light switch may be installed quickly and easily in an existing wall outlet or in new construction. It is recommended for installation on porches, in garages, bedrooms, basements and stairways.

The switch may be installed in any standard switch opening. Wires from the old switch are disconnected and attached to side screws in the delayed action switch, after which the regular switch plate is replaced. The extra minute of light is especially useful where there are children or elderly people or in dark neighborhoods, for there is enough time before darkness to get off the porch, out to the garage, down the hall or into bed.

The switch is now on display and can be purchased at several local business places.

FLAME-PROOF CLOTH

A flame-resistant finish for cotton cloth has been developed by the Department of Agriculture Research Laboratory in Louisiana. It will be some time before the materials finished with the process will be available for homemakers use. When they are, it will mean cotton cloth that is more fire-resistant and lighter in weight. The fire resistant material will be used for work garments, military uniforms, camp outfits and upholstery and curtain fabric.
