University of Michigan scientists use many forms of radioactivity in their research at Ann Arbor. Two bundles of radioactive cobalt, each more powerful than all the radium in the world, are used behind heavy shielding to pasteurize foods, sterilize bones and other materials, and to trigger chemical reactions.

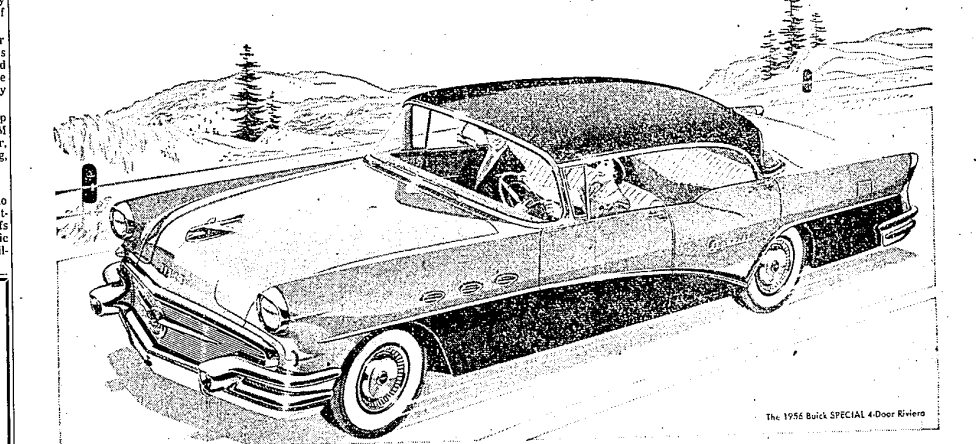
