Highway Commissioner Gives Views Against Telegraph - Cypress Light

"The State Highway department is deeply concerned about the safety of children going to and from school, and we are always ready to make any reasonable concession to improve their safety."

Wick Road which was approved with no left turns allowed. Traffic congestion on Telegraph Road below Sibley Road will be relieved by the fall of 1955, when the Toledo - North, 4-lane divided, limited access expressway will be opened to traffic as a part of the National Interstate Highway System.

"The average daily traffic count on Telegraph Road at Cypress Street is 30,000 vehicles. The traffic count on Cypress Street crossing Telegraph Road is only 39 vehicles in the peak eight hours of daylight. Of these 39 vehicle crossings, 12 are made by school buses. There are only 808 vehicles on Cypress Street in the same peak eight hours during to left-turn from Cypress onto Telegraph Road.

"To delay the traffic movement of 30,000 vehicles with a stop-and-go light, which would serve a total of only 247 vehicles in eight hours, is unreasonable and extremely hazardous."

"The Taylor Township Board of Education has accepted the Highway Department's solution of routing plans prepared by the Department with the cooperation of the Wayne County Road commission and the State Police show an overall decrease in travel distance for the school buses."

"No children are required to rush school on foot. All are provided with bus transportation both ways."

"The individual streets used for these routes must be determined by the school board to suit its own needs. The Highway Department's purpose in advocating the school bus route change is to accomplish a safe crossing of Telegraph Road by the use of the Ecorse road overpass, only a block and a half from Cypress Street. Side streets of a character similar to those presently used are available for these routings on an existing street system."

"Leroy C. Smith, Wayne County Road Commission Engineer, has advised us that crossing protection at Pardee-Ecorse Washburn Railroad crossing, will be installed at once and Pardee Road widened to make this crossing as safe as any crossing. Trains are limited as to speed in that area."

"Telegraph Road through Wayne County is a very heavily traveled trunkline. It has been under study for several years. The development, both residential and commercial, along this road has constantly changed the character of the traffic and the operational problems. This route has always carried a high percentage of commercial traffic and the increased volume of local traffic has contributed greatly to the accident experience during the past couple of years."

"With this constant change in traffic usage the Highway Department has from time to time found it necessary to install traffic signals at major highway crossings, regulate speeds and restrict certain turning movements. The latest of these installations was at
