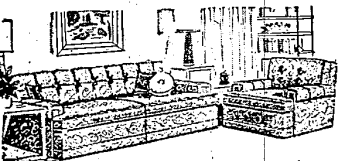

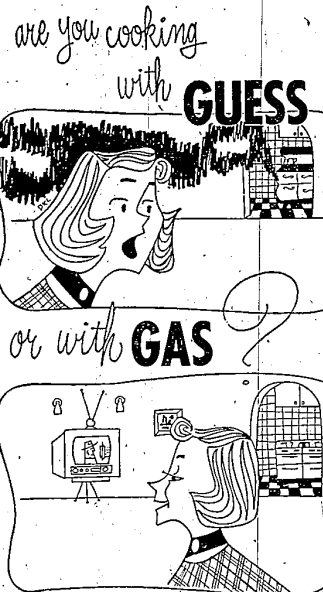

## Report Heavy School Enrollment

A report from the Farmington Public Schools last week revealed that 38 new students had been enrolled in the various schools in the district during the week following holiday vacations.

The heaviest enrollment was reported in the day which school resumed, Tuesday, January 3, when 28 students were registered in the various schools. The biggest enrollment took place at the Bond School, where 15 were enrolled on the first day and two others later in the week.

This represents a need for approximately one and one-third additional classrooms in the school system, school officials pointed out. This is based on a desired maximum of 30 youngsters to a classroom.

A later report from the Livonia school district revealed a much sharper enrollment increase. A total of 63 new pupils were enrolled in the Livonia system on Tuesday, January 3, school officials stated. This is a record enrollment for one day during the school year, they said.

bring enough traffic to pay off the bond issue.

One observer quipped that the bond-financed turnpike could go broke carrying traffic to the bridge which would go broke without it.

At the same time, Highway Commissioner Charles M. Ziegler is insisting on free roads, opposing turnpikes "unless they are soundly financed."

Highways will be the major issues of the 1956 legislative session - and, most certainly, of the 1956 national and state election campaigns.

**FARMERS HAVE A champion** in the 1956 session as a marketing and promotion campaign gets attention.

Governor Williams has assigned top agricultural experts to help devise a program which they estimate at the moment will cost \$131,000.

The emphasis in the state agricultural department is on marketing on promotion and marketing.

Two new commissions are particularly interested in this field. Edward C. Meade, former agricultural trouble shooter in Williams' office, and Theo Fenon, both practicing farmers.

The idea of the agricultural commission is to create a new division in the department, increasing the number and effectiveness of farm crop marketing before products reach the market.

They deny that this is another way to get Governor Williams' proposed "Seal of Quality" idea into effect, but Meade admits that "it would be a logical corresponding move."

Details of the plan still have to be worked out, but all concerned promise it will be ready for the session.
