To Swing Big-Bat Again

Women's Rights Ready

By W.W. EDGAR

The champion of women's rights in the Congress of the United States has come to bat again. This time U.S. Representative Martha W. Griffiths (D. 17th District) has come to the defense of 12-year-old Carolyn King, who has been denied the right to play Little league baseball - even though the officials of her hometown in Ypsilanti have threat-ened to deny the use of the eithy playfields to the Little League.

Speaking on the floor of Congress last week, Mrs. Griffiths pointed to the flaw in the legislation that created the Little League and limited competition to boys.

In stressing her point that the law was discriminatory, she introduced a bill that would amend the present statute to permit girls to compete for positions on Little League teams on the same basis as the boys.

"There are very few courses of action available to correct this discriminatory situation," she told her colleagues. "We could repeal the act that incorporated Little League baseball. We could even

enact legislation that would to minate Little League baseball's tax exempt status. We "There is only one real affernative open to Congress and this is to amend the it...

"This would place girls origin equal footing with
the boys under the Little League's federal charter
and I am introducing such a bill."
Mrs. Griffiths stressed the fact to her colleagues
that there are no hidden results in her bill. Girls
would not be required to use, the same locker room
as the boys. If a girl was renjoved from the game
because she was pitching pooily she would not be
sent to the men's showers.
She also stressed the point hat a girl who could
not field ground balls or hit fair balls would not be
granted any more advantage in "getting on the
