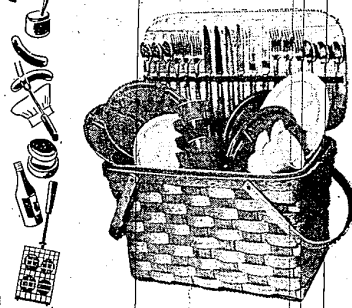

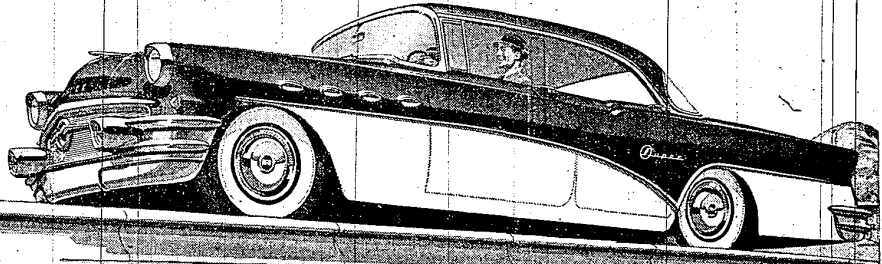
The first of four two-week camping periods will start this Saturday, June 30.

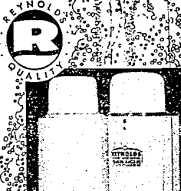
