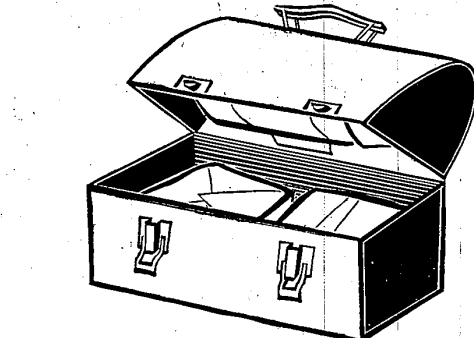

Lodge Seeks State Senate Seat

Seeking re-nomination as a Republican candidate for the State Senate in the Oakland County District is L. Harvey Lodge, who makes his home at 6610 Longworth in Drayton Plains.

Lodge was born in Milford and is a lifelong resident of Oakland County. In former governmental positions he has served as Assistant Attorney General of Michigan and as Prosecuting Attorney of Oakland County. He is the only candidate who has had previous experience in the Legislature.

If nominated and elected, Lodge has promised to press for more and better roads in Oakland County, an adequate water supply for the entire county obtained from the Great Lakes, and a uniform plan for sewage disposal as well as improved drainage, especially in southern Oakland County. He also promises to work for more school building aid, a broadening of township government powers, a better tax structure, and numerous other county-wide improvements.

ones." The seven Hungarians who overpowered the Communist crew of a Budapest airliner and flew it into West Germany and freedom on July 13 are real people. Moisture Barrier Reduces Peeling Of Outside Paint

Paint peeling on the outside of a building can be reduced considerably by putting on a moisture barrier when redecorating, says James Boyd, an engineer at Michigan State University.

He advises two coats of good quality lead and oil paint or aluminum paint as a moisture barrier, especially for the kitchen and bathroom walls. The decorating color can be painted over the aluminum.

Home builders are advised to place a moisture barrier, such as plastic film, under the inside finish. If insulation is used that includes aluminum foil, however, the plastic film is not necessary.

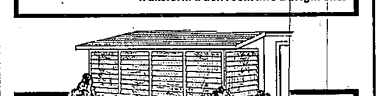
