Crash Kills Carl Budde

FARMINGTON Carl Budde, 30, owner of Budde Sports Shop, 33161 Farmington, was killed early Thursday morning in an auto mishap on I-94 at the Huron River exit.

Budde, who was driving, apparently mistook the exit as a continuation of the expressway, according to his brother, Ronald, a passenger in the car.

Realizing his error at the last instant, he attempted to swerve, hit the shoulder of the road and lost control of the car, Ronald said. The accident happened about 3 a.m.

Budde, who lived in Pleasant Ridge, was pronounced dead on arrival at Wayne County General Hospital.

Ronald Budde, a Garden City resident, sustained minor injuries.

Funeral services will be Monday at 11 a.m. at Kinsey-Garrett Funeral Home, 420 S. Lafayette, Royal Oak.
