ANN ARBOR — "Women in Art — Men as Patrons" is the title of a talk to be given at the University of Michigan's 21st annual art conference.

The conference will be held Thursday, July 19 in the Modern Languages Building (across the street from the Rackham Building).

Registrations will begin at 8:30 a.m., and the keynote address will be given at 10 a.m. The speaker will be Diane Kirkpatrick, assistant professor of art history, U-M.

Besides being an art historian, she has studied painting and sculpture at the Cranbrook Academy of Art and the Courland Institute of Art, London, England.

At 11:30 a.m. the U-M's 21st annual international art exhibition will open in the Rackham Galleries. This will be open through Aug. 3.

In the afternoon, at 2 p.m., there will be demonstrations in painting by Win Jones, nationally known watercolorist, and Lupo Biro, who specializes in relief painting.

At 3:30, there will be a talk by Russell Keeter, instructor of painting at the Art School of the Society of Arts and Crafts.
