## Bike-Hiking Calls For Some Hearty Treats

Although the wheel was invented in the days when a man's home was his cave, it took centuries before he put one and one together and came up with the bicycle.

The first bicycles, appropriately named "bone shakers," were popular with only the most daring males who risked life and limb every time they went for a ride.

It was not until the late 19th century invention of the pneumatic tire and the later modification of the drop-frame for modestly the sake that bicycling became the leisure pastime for men and women alike.

And yet, the Women's Rescue League still found reason to issue this warning to women: If ladies continue to participate in the sport of bicycling they shall become invalids with the decade.

However, other women, most notably fashion pace-setter Amelia Bloomer, called bicycling the beginning of female emancipation.

Gather your friends of a feather and flock together on a bike hike through the country. When the trek is over, bring the travelers home for tandem treats like Swiss corned beef with slaw, marinated tomato and asparagus, and open face peach pie with a variety of sour cream toppings.

### CORNERED BEEF AND SLAW CARRY-ALONG

SLAW: 2 c. shredded cabbage 1/2 c. shredded carrot 1/2 c. chopped green pepper 2 t. sugar 2 t. vinegar 2 t. prepared horseradish 1/2 t. seasoned salt 1/2 c. dairy sour cream 1/2 slices cooked corned beef 6 slices Swiss cheese

To prepare, slaw: In a large bowl toss together cabbage, carrot, green pepper and onion. In a bowl combine sugar, vinegar, horseradish and seasoned salt; fold in sour cream. Add to vegetables and toss. (Yield: approx. 2 1/2 cups) In an oblong casserole or pan arrange two slices corned beef for each serving. Top with one slice of cheese and about 1/2 cup slaw. Cover and keep chilled until serving time. Makes six servings.

### MARINATED ASPARAGUS AND TOMATOES

#### DRESSING:

1/2 c. salad oil 1/4 c. finely crumbled blue cheese 2 T. white wine vinegar 1 T. water 1/2 t. sugar 1/2 t. dry mustard 1/2 t. paprika 1/2 t. salt 1 pig. (10 oz.) frozen asparagus spears 3 medium tomatoes

To prepare dressing: In a jar with cover combine oil, blue cheese, vinegar, water, sugar, mustard, paprika and salt. Set aside. (Yield: 3/4 cup) Cook asparagus according to package directions; drain and cool. Peel and slice tomatoes. Arrange asparagus and tomatoes in shallow refrigerator dish. Shake dressing well and pour over all. Cover and chill several hours. Makes six servings.

### OPEN FACE PEACH PIE

1 unbaked pie shell, 9-inch 1/2 c. sugar 1/4 c. (1/2 stick) butter, melted 2 T. all-purpose flour 1 egg 1 t. almond extract 5 t. peeled sliced (fresh peaches (about 10 medium))

In a mixing bowl beat together sugar, butter, flour, egg and almond extract. Place peaches in pie shell; pour egg mixture over top. Bake in a preheated 350-degree oven, 60-70 minutes or until peaches are tender. Serve with Sour Cream Toppers.

### SOUR CREAM TOPPERS:

(Yield: 1 cup each) To 1 cup dairy sour cream blend in one of the following combinations: 1/2 teaspoon almond extract and four teaspoons confectioners sugar; OR two teaspoons brown sugar, 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg and 1 teaspoon cinnamon; OR 1 teaspoon brandy extract and 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg.
