The Board, at its regular meeting on Thursday evening, is expected to take action setting up the procedure and deadlines for receiving of proposals. A separate study is being made on necessary kitchen equipment to be installed in the new building and a report will be submitted to the Board in the near future.

It was the opinion of the board that residents of the subdivision should express these opinions to the City Council immediately. Superintendent Dunkel suggested to the board that they might consider an elementary unit of eight classrooms to be added at the new Junior High site. He stated that the suggestion was being made in view of the difficulties being encountered in locating a suitable third site and because of the fact that at present there may not be sufficient funds to build as many new elementary rooms at the three schools as was originally planned.

In answer to a letter from the Forest Hills subdivision the Board authorized an investigation of conditions on property owned by Mrs. Olga Rice. Gain was directed to check the situation to see if a nuisance existed and to take whatever action is necessary to correct the situation. According to the letter, the property is in unsatisfactory condition and that old cars are being stored on the property.
