Cites Three Ways To Raise More City Taxes
"Cities hard pressed for tax revenue have three ways to secure more funds, Arthur W. Bromage, University of Michigan professor of political science, reported in a recent issue of The Michigan Municipal Review.
Working the property tax harder, obtaining more state-allocated local share revenues, or levying local non-property taxes are the three possibilities for obtaining additional revenues in Michigan," said Professor Bromage.

"It is up to the municipal officials and state legislators to decide which route Michigan should take," he continues.

So far, Michigan has centered on a proposed bill to permit cities and villages to levy an income tax after a local referendum. "This bill was modeled to be the first of its kind in the United States," Professor Bromage explains. "It proposed that incorporated cities and villages be empowered to impose a local specific tax on income, salaries, wages, commissions." It also includes taxes on net profits earned by persons, firms or corporations from businesses, professions, or other activities at a rate not to exceed one per cent per annum.

If this plan was put into effect, municipal property taxes would be decreased, Professor Bromage points out. "With the continuing crisis in school funds, which would be a result of this plan, the assumption is that school districts will continue to work the property tax hard or even harder."

Another line of diversification of city revenues more logical in the long run.

Ways To Prevent, Care For Common Colds Suggested

Dr. Joseph G. Moirer, commissioner of health, says most persons who have colds or flu can avoid some have several. The three peak periods for colds are early Fall, late December and January and

Head colds, gripple and influenza are infectious diseases caused by viruses, he states. So far as is known, these viruses are not a threat by air or other remedy. Secondary infections, such as pneumonia, which follow colds to respond to treatment by antibiotics. These treatments should be given only under the direction of a physician.

It pays off to take every possible precaution to avoid a cold and if you do get one, to take care of yourself when it begins, Moirer said. Colds spread rapidly because most persons are susceptible and few have any real immunity to them. Colds are dangerous chiefly because they lower resistance of the breathing passages to germs such as the pneumococcus bacteria, which are often present in the nose and throat, but cause illness only under conditions which are favorable to them. This is the reason a cold often precedes pneumonia, sinus infection or ear infection. Children younger than five years old are most likely to be affected.

Dr. Moirer suggests the following precautions for avoiding colds: 1. Whenever possible, stay away from anyone who has a cold and be especially careful to protect young children from anyone who coughs or sneezes carelessly. 2. Get enough sleep to wake refreshed, get enough rest.

3. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water before eating or handling food. 4. Eat meals that are well balanced.

5. Avoid overfatigue, but do plan to have some recreation. 6. Dress according to the weather. Wear light clothing when outdoors, but keep warm and extra clothes ready to put on when you are inactive.

When you catch a cold, it is usually minor and will pass more quickly if you take good care of yourself from the beginning. Get as much rest as you can. Keep comfortably warm and dry. If you have a fever, take medicine suitable for the weather. Eat simple, easily digested foods. Drink plenty of liquids—especially water and citrus fruit.

Consult your doctor if you have chills, fever and aching, or if the cold is more than usually severe. Do not take medicine unless a physician's direction. Even though a relief measure may be helpful, it is without the doctor's advice.

If you have a cold and feel you must work, be sure to do everything you can to protect others. Do not go to work or school if you are coughing and sneezing, and if you feel that you need not be touched by others.

Taking Special Law Course On Atomic Energy
The impact of private atomic energy development on traditional legal concepts is now being studied by 15 University of Michigan law students in a course believed to be the first of its kind in the Midwest. The University disclosed this week.

One of the 15 select students taking the course is Loren E. Hankins, a professor of law located in Farmington at 33110 Grand River.

Working with a top-level faculty team the students are examining many topics which as yet have hard and fast guiding legal principles. Subjects covered include municipal property taxes, control of atomic enterprise, state regulation, liability for radiation injuries, patent law and international law as it is affected by atomic development.

Dean E. Blythe Stagon, chairman of the American-Bar Association special committee on atomic energy law is part of the faculty (teaching the seminar). Others are Professor Samuel D. Estep, Associate Professor Eric Sigmund, Associate Professor William Pierce and Assistant Professor Rinaldo Bianchi. All have worked extensively in this fast-growing field of legal concepts.
