

andyman's NOTEBOOK

by: BAYARD TUPPER NEW VISTAS IN PLYWOOD

If you've been paying attention during the last few years, you've undoubtedly noticed that plywood isn't just the same old stuff it was a few years ago.

In fact, with the use of hardwood veneers, plywood has beome one of the most beautiful as well as versatile of all building materials. It is not only easy to work with, but also offers tremendous variety of surfaces and textures.

So if you're getting ready to make a new wall or panel an old one, don't order plain fir plywood until you've had a look at plywoods with finishes in such attractive woods as mahogany, walnut, oak, birch and cherry.

And look into the possibility of different types of surface treatments, too, such as the widely popular straited finish; or you can go to work on a plain surface to give it a grooved finish, for an appearance of heavy planking. The groowing, joidentally, serves two other purposes — it relieves the unbroken expanse of a big wall, and it allows you to make unobtrusive joints between sheets, without battens.

Another smart thing to do before you actually get the job under way is to investigate the use of adhesive instead of nails. An adhesive has the outstanding advantage of permitting installation right over an old wall, without any regard to where the stude might be. Thus this method saves a lot of work and will sometimes save on phywood jas well, because you can make your, joint wherever the edge, of the sheet happens to come.

Of course there are innumerable ways of finishing any type of plywood, although most people who pick a hardwood finish prefer to give it a natural treatment with clear shellae or wax. Come in and see our plywoods soon. You'll be crazy
